It is an alleyway called "Hwangnam Main Road" in the Poseok-ro area of Hwangnam-dong, and is a popular place for young people to visit as there are many traditional hanok-style cafes, restaurants, and photo studios. The name "Hwangnidan-gil" is a combination of Hwangnam-dong and Itaewon's Gyeongnidan-gil, which means "Gyeongridan-gil in Hwangnam-dong." Hwangridan-gil is a street where you can feel the old atmosphere intact as old buildings from the 1960s and 1970s are preserved, and you can tour the nearby tourist attractions of Cheomseongdae and Daereungwon, making it a popular attraction in Gyeongju.





- Daereungwon Tomb

Within Daereungwon Tomb Complex is Cheonmachong Tomb (Ancient Tomb No. 155), which was excavated in 1973. Cheonmachong Tomb consists of a wooden coffin placed inside an underground chamber mounded with boulders and earth, characterized as a typical upper class tomb of the Silla period. The mound has a height of 12.7 m with a diameter of 50 m, and consists of a layer of rocks collected from streams. Below the rock layer is a wooden chamber with a length of 6.5 m and a width of 2.1, reaching 2.1 m in height, with the wooden coffin at its center. A total of 11,526 artifacts were discovered within the tomb, including Cheonmado, an artwork considered to be highly valuable as it is Korea's first artwork to be excavated from an ancient tomb.



- Cheonmseongdae Observatory

		<p>Cheomseongdae is the oldest existing astronomical observatory in Asia. Constructed during the reign of Queen Seon-deok (r. 632-647), it was used for</p>  <p>observing the stars in order to forecast the weather. This stone structure is a beautiful combination of straight lines and curves, and was designated as National Treasure No.31 on December 20th, 1962.</p> <p>- Donggung Palace and Wolji Pond</p> <p>Gyeongju Donggung Palace and Wolji Pond were the secondary palace site which was used for the palace of the Crown Prince along with other subsidiary buildings and it also was the banquet site for important national event and important visitors.</p> <p>- Overnight in Gyeongju</p>	
<p>Day 2</p>	<p>Gyeongju - Seoul</p>	 <p>- Bulguksa Temple</p> <p>Also listed as one of UNESCO World Heritage, it is the representative relic of Gyeongju. Bulguksa was built during Silla Dynasty and took 30 years to finish it. At the time, there were approximately 80 buildings and 2000 rooms. It was burnt down during Japanese Invasion and although the temple was rebuilt afterwards, it still suffered severe damages and became often the target of robbers</p> <p>After Gyeongju Tour, Move to Seoul by KTX and Tour ends at Seoul Station.</p> <p>*KTX : TBA</p>	<p>No Meal</p>
